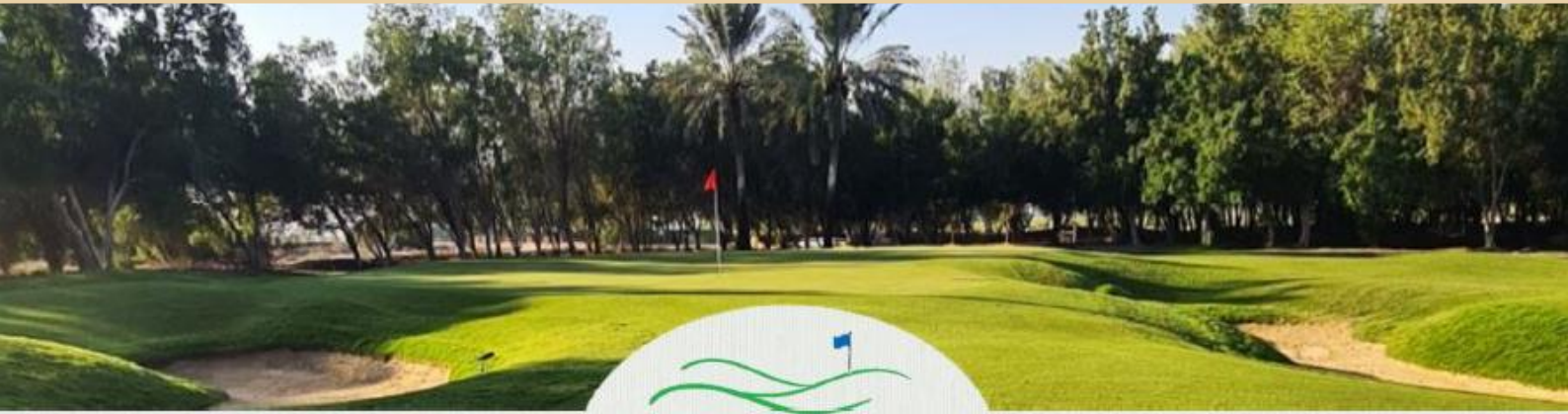

Golf Etiquette



The number of unrepaired or poorly repaired pitch marks on our greens has become an issue. Please help maintain the condition of our course for all our members and prevent perfect putts from being knocked off line because of an unrepaired or poorly repaired pitch mark by repairing them correctly.

Pushing the bottom of the depression upward only tears the roots, and kills the grass.
